### Mission Statement:

We provide a complex aircraft at a reasonable rate to pilots that want to have the greatest flying adventures of their lives.

### General Club Information

1. Our Aircraft consists of a Mooney M20C with 200HP Fuel Injected Engine.
2. We are located at KTMB, with two runways, low traffic density, and a friendly environment.
3. Scheduling is available for trips of up to 5 days, after the 5<sup>th</sup> days, additional charges will apply.
4. Okay to fly to the Bahamas.
5. Club-owned survival gear (rafts, life jackets, GPS locators) at no charge.
6. We offer easy online scheduling.
7. Each member holds his/her own keys to each aircraft.
8. Billing is based on a wet rate, tach-time at \$88 / per our hours.
9. There is a deposit fee of \$1,500.00; \$500 refundable after 6 months of active membership should a club member decide to leave the club.
10. Monthly dues are \$130. This pays for fixed expenses and insurance.
11. Bills for flying time and dues are sent out monthly via email.
12. Club approved instructors are available for flight reviews, instrument proficiency checks, and instrument training, and Checked outs.
13. We hold monthly meetings, often with educational programs and occasional social outings.

### All Club members must meet the following club insurance requirements:

1. Have a minimum of a Private Pilot Certificate.
2. Have a current and effective medical certificate.
3. Satisfy the FAA's flight review requirements and all applicable FAA requirements.
4. Have at least 250 hours of total logged PIC flight time or an instrument rating.  
A member with less than 250 hours PIC may acquire club approved.
